Members of the public are advised that competent authorities of Trinidad and Tobago in keeping with its legislative and international obligations have taken the following action:

High Court Order CV 2016-03997 and CV 2016-03975 has been revoked.

The revocation of the aforementioned Court Orders has the following effect:

- i. The one (1) individual named therein, Ahmad (formerly known as Abu Mohammed) is no longer a listed individual pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07:
- ii. The one (1) individual named therein, Anas is no longer a listed individual pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07; and
- iii. The funds are no longer frozen.

In light of the foregoing, there are no longer restrictions on transactions involving the property of the aforementioned individuals.

You are reminded that the provision of financial and/or any other related services, property and/or support to any continuing "listed entity" is an offence pursuant to the Anti-Terrorism Act, Chap. 12:07 in Trinidad and Tobago.
